MASSDEP – WATER MANAGEMENT ACT PROGRAM
WATER WITHDRAWAL PERMIT APPLICATION

The Cotuit Fire District Water Department (District) has applied to the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) Water Management Act Program for a permit to increase an existing registered and permitted withdrawal volume of 0.64 million gallons per day (mgd) to 0.81 mgd (including a ten percent buffer of 0.08 mgd) of water from the District's existing active permitted water supply wells located within the Cape Cod watershed in Cotuit, Massachusetts, through the year 2030. The locations of the withdrawal sources are:
